- The total text size is 500 characters, spaced (Arial font, 12 font size, line spacing 1.0), including:

Abstract title

- Full name of the author (authors) (the corresponding author should be marked with an asterisk)
- Author affiliation
- Email address: the corresponding author's email address should be written
- The main part of the text should briefly indicate the relevance of the study, its goals, objectives, materials, methods, results, and conclusions.
- Funding source (grant/program name, grant number, etc.)
- The text of the abstract cannot be edited; the authors are solely responsible for its accuracy.
